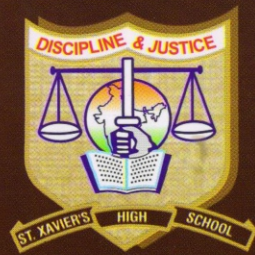

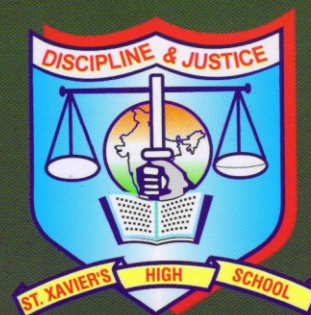

Our prime concern is to ensure overall development of the child by helping him towards holistic growth. This aspect can only be inculcated in a child's personality if a disciplined lifestyle is introduced in his lifestyle at the nascent level itself. Keeping the same as our prime focus, discipline in school is given prime importance.

A few ground rules that must be followed and abided by every individual student in / around the school premises are :

- ◆ It is mandatory for all students to be in the school premises 10 minutes prior the assembly. The students who have arrived late will not be permitted to enter the class without a permission slip signed by the principal.
- ◆ Absolute silence should be maintained within the classrooms during teaching time and also during period breaks, so that teachers and students in other classes are not disturbed. Perfect decorum should be maintained.

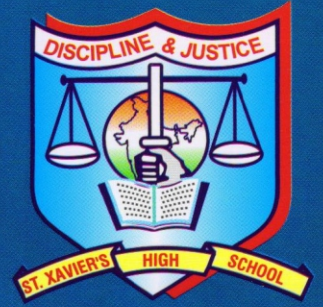

for parents

It is not just the duty of the teacher to ensure a child's development, parents are equally responsible. Thus, it becomes the duty of the parents to keep a check on the performance of their child.

- ◆ A school diary has been allotted to all the students which on regular basis with updated thus it is essential for the parents to read the school diary.
- ◆ Any remarks written by the teacher or parents should be counter signed in the diary which will ensure that the message has been passed on to the concerned person.
- ◆ Students missing the classes in mid-session for attending social functions will be discouraged.
- ◆ Children should do their homework independently without the help of their parents or the least help required. This will help the students to develop a habit of studying.
- ◆ Parents are not allowed to meet the ward in between the school hours, unless there is an emergency.
- ◆ Private tuition is discouraged.



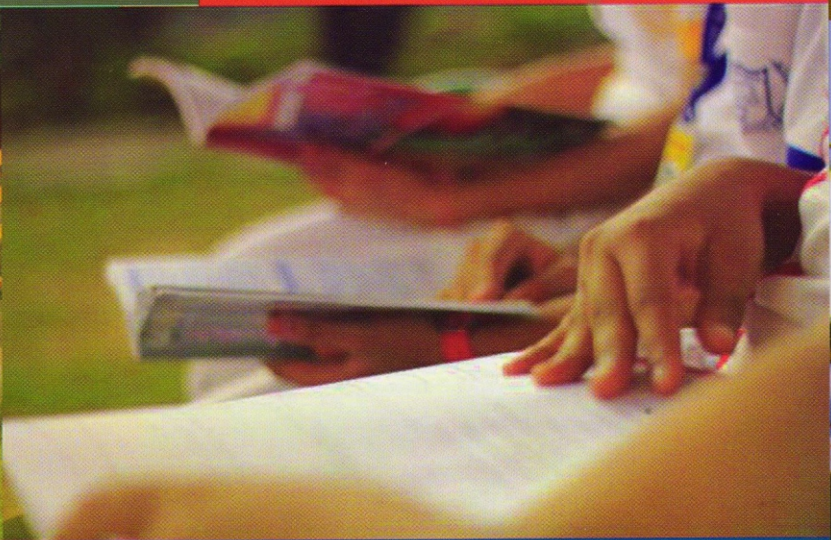


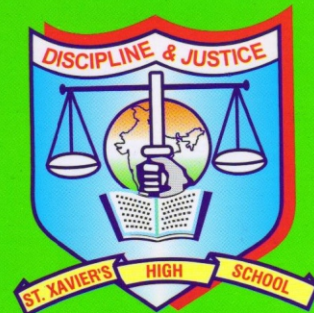
PARENTS GUIDELINES

- ◆ Since the school is an English Medium school, the children to be encouraged to make healthy conversations in English within the school premises and parents should encourage the same at home.
- ◆ Parents are requested to ensure that the child is carrying the books according to the timetable allotted to them by their class teachers.
- ◆ Parents should make a conscious effort to motivate their child to take part in sports, extra-curricular activities and other school events which will help them to develop an all round personality.
- ◆ Parents should make sure that the child is not wearing any valuable Jewelry or ornaments. Applying mehendi is also not accepted by the school.
- ◆ Supplementary notices will be placed in the front cover flap of the school diary. The parents must acknowledge it.
- ◆ It is mandatory to maintain the diary neatly till the end of the year and the student should carry it daily.
- ◆ If there is something that the parent wants to communicate to the teachers or the school authority, they are permitted to write it in the dairy in the "Parents remarks request" column.
- ◆ The students of St. Xavier's should not just be recognized by the school uniform but also by their code of conduct and behaviour.

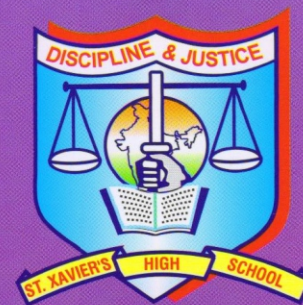
STUDENT GUIDELINES

- ◆ Comics, magazines or any kind of explicit books will not be allowed & will be confiscated.
- ◆ Students shouldn't bring valuable goods to school and belongings must be tagged to reduce the probability of losing.
- ◆ Any student found using unfair means during the examination will be debarred from taking further exams apart from other strict actions.
- ◆ The students are not allowed to drive a personal vehicle without a written consent signed by the parents and the principal both.
- ◆ The students are not permitted to leave the school premises at mid-school hours. The parents are also kindly requested not to encourage something similar.
- ◆ Attending the parent-teacher meeting is a mandate for the students and their parents at the starting of each term (Summer, Dusshehra and Winter). The student who is absent on this day, 2 marks per subject would be deducted.
- ◆ There will be more-examination for the students absent during exams and the promotion can also be on a halt.
- ◆ All students are expected to join the school on the notified date of joining. There will be a fine of Rs. 50/- imposed on the students who would join late, unless they have informed the principal in a prior notice.
- ◆ In-case of the child suffering from a contagious disease, the parents must inform the school. The parents must also send a clearance letter from the doctor that the student is fit to attend the regular classes.
- ◆ A healthy attendance in class isn't just appreciated but also applauded during the flag assembly on the last day of the term. Hence, leave applications during the term will not be permitted and the parents should try and abide by it.

EXAMINATION & ASSESSMENT

At St. Xavier's High School, teaching isn't just about testing the memory of students. A lot of attention is paid by our teachers at an individual level for each child.

Our teachers while being a mentor to the students are aware of the progress made and are also precise about where the child is lacking behind. A conscious effort is made by the teacher who mandatorily informs the parents about the same so that a focused approach is exercised at home for those particular subjects. Teachers also assign work to such students on a daily basis with a motive to strengthen the weaker areas.

Apart from the aforementioned approach, the teachers also focus on the fact that whether a discipline and routine revision of the weak subjects has been followed such students or not in order to bring about regularity in work.

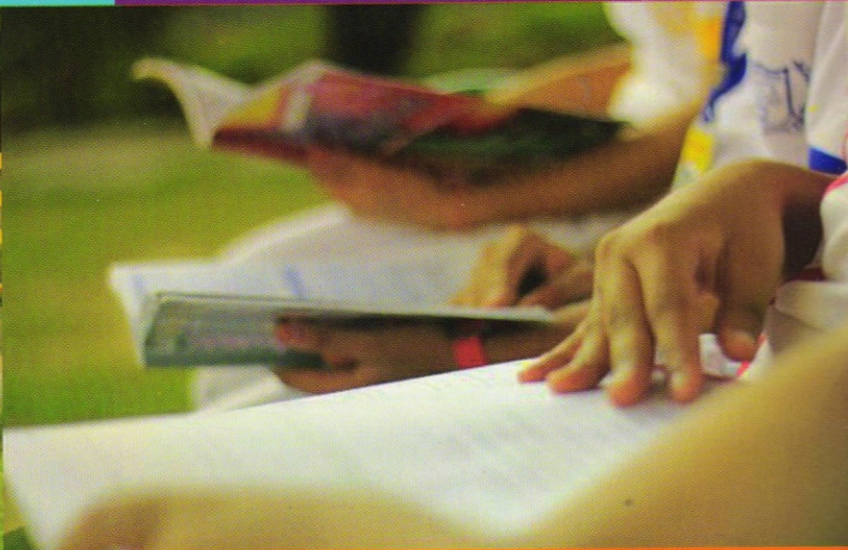
The students must be prepared for a surprise test and class tests. Proper revision of subjects would yield better result and lead to better performance.

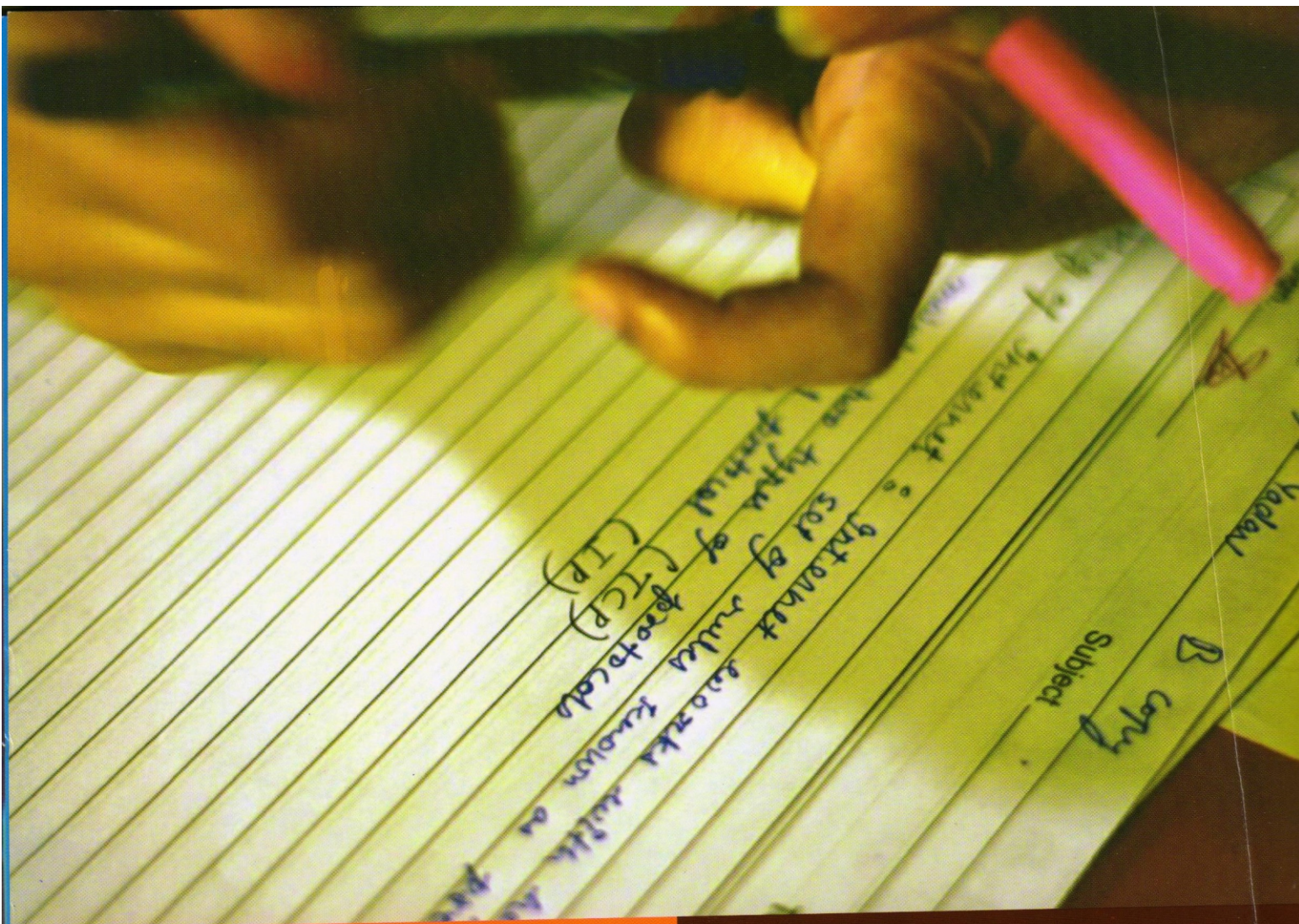
Through a proper question-answer method the teachers help to build up the child's confidence.

There will be a Periodic evaluation of maximum marks earned by a student for each individual subject according to its nature and educational stream and the evaluation formats have pre-prescribed evaluation formats for the same.

- ◆ Subject based evaluation & subsequent promotions are applicable for classes I to VIII.
- ◆ The periodic assessment will be taken in all the subjects from time to time.
- ◆ Ranks will be given according to the grade given to the students viz. 1st Rank | 2nd Rank | 3rd Rank.
- ◆ Highest Marks in Subjects would also be awarded to well-versed and reasoned answer sheets from students.
- ◆ Periodic marking and formative assessments are applicable on all subjects including - English, Maths, Science, Hindi & Social Studies.



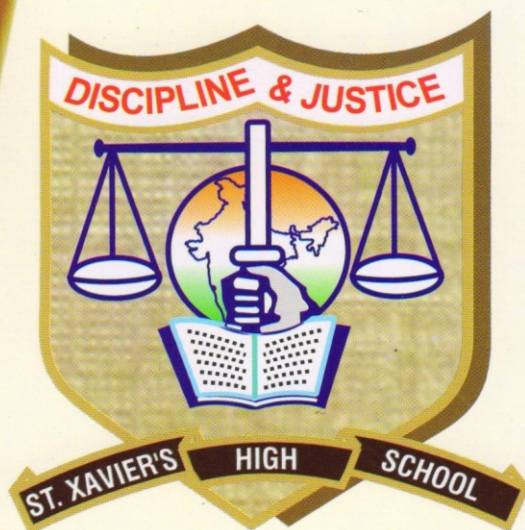

- ◆ The school dues shall be settled at the school fees- counter.
- ◆ Parents need to kindly ensure that the fees for their ward(s) get submitted on time or else a daily fine of Rs5/- will be charged and a monthly fine of Rs 100/- will be charged.
- ◆ Transport fees will be charged according to the distance and on an annual basis.
- ◆ Depositing of the school fees by students of primary and secondary classes are not encouraged by the school as an ethical practice.
- ◆ At the beginning of the new academic session, fees of the student should be paid on time or else the name of the child can be removed from the admission list.
